We're building for you

The approximately 19 kilometre railway line Feldkirch – Buchs SG connects the three countries of Austria, Liechtenstein and Switzerland. To ensure safe and punctual railway service, ÖBB-Infrastruktur AG is carrying out construction and maintenance work:

- Renewal of 3 points and 1 track including ballast bed and substrate at Nendeln station
- Renewal of the carriageway at the railway crossings Rheinstraße and Schwemmeggass; closure of Rheinstraße and Schwemmeggass with traffic diversion from 1st to 12th November 2021
- Installation of a temporary bridge for the renewal of the railway bridge over the Small Liechtenstein Inland Canal
- Renovation work on the bridge over the large Liechtenstein inland canal

Work will also continue during the night and on the weekend. Unfortunately we cannot entirely prevent noise and dust.
